

PAINTS

Tubes of Paint, Not the Dried Cakes in Pans *These are suggested colors. You're welcome to use what you have

Neutral Tint Paynes Gray Ultramarine Blue Cobalt Blue Cerulean Blue Raw Sienna

Burnt Sienna Quinacridone Gold Alizarin Crimson Cadmium Red Cadmium Lemon

PALETTE

Must have good size mixing area. The John Pike palette is wonderful

BRUSHES

I typically use a squirrel hair mop brush for big early washes Size 14 or 16 sable for the intermediate washes Size 10 synthetic for detail work Silver makes a good variety of Black Velvet round watercolor brushes

Cheap Joe's Pseudo Sable is a good option

PAPER

I use Arches and Kiliminjaro cold press and Saunders 140 lb. rough Have handy a 9x12 pad of watercolor paper for value studies

MISC.

No. 2 pencil and kneaded eraser Water container Household sponge and a natural sponge Masking tape
